Throughout her career in law and public policy, Carole has distinguished herself as a strategic leader and a trusted advisor to policymakers and executives alike. Before joining McKesson, Carole worked in Washington, D.C., as Counsel on the U.S. Senate Judiciary Committee where she advised U.S. Senator Dianne Feinstein on immigration and constitutional law as well as the intersecting issues of criminal justice, healthcare, civil rights, privacy, national security, and economic reform. Carole previously served as Legislative Counsel to U.S.

Representative Jerrold Nadler (NY-8) during his chairmanship of the U.S. House of Representatives Judiciary Subcommittee on Civil Rights and Civil Liberties.

As a staff attorney at Legal Momentum (formerly NOW Legal Defense Fund), Carole served as the point person for the National Network to End Violence Against Immigrant Women and drafted provisions passed in the reauthorization of the Violence Against Women Act, expanding protections for immigrant victims of domestic violence, trafficking, and sexual assault.

Carole is an active member of her local and global community. She has spoken and published extensively on a range of public policy and legal topics and was recognized in the American Bar Association Journal's "The DC Power Web." Carole is a graduate of Leadership Atlanta, Class of 2012, and volunteers with Jewish Family & Career Services, where she supports refugee families in their transition to Atlanta. Carole currently serves on the Board of Directors of the Georgia Coalition Against Domestic Violence and has volunteered in Port-au-Prince, Haiti, as part of earthquake rebuilding efforts.

Carole is admitted to practice law in Maryland and the District of Columbia. She is a member of the American Bar Association, American Health Lawyers Association, and the Academy of Health. Carole

earned her Juris Doctorate from the University of Maryland School of Law, and her bachelor's degree in Government and Politics from the University of Maryland. She resides in Brookhaven with her husband and daughter.
